## <u>Points to Note for Club secretaries and to be</u> <u>shared and circulated as appropriate</u>




There is a code of conduct that we expect all of our players, spectators and coaches to adhere to. Please ensure that all of your club community are aware of this document

Spectators are not allowed court side, they must remain outside of the playing area

Scorers MUST be stood together, check the score regularly and call out the score so that umpires and players are aware. Scorers MUST be provided in Div 1 and Div 2. In Div 3 and Div 4 they are optional. If, in Div 3 and Div 4, teams choose to have scorers, there must be two (one from each team)

Score cards should be written clearly and neatly. Players names should be printed as well as signed and the team number should be written as well as the club name. Please do not shorten club names. Scorecards MUST be dated, signed by the umpire and pictures of both sides sent via message / WhatsApp to Joyce on 07870595682



Central timing for all quarters. Games start promptly at 09:30 and 11:15

Please ensure that your umpire knows the time they are umpiring for you and the court. Their name should be inputted on the <u>umpiring sheet</u>

First team on the fixture is the **HOME team**. The **HOME** team place their belongings in the middle of the courts and provide the match ball

**Division 1 umpiring** is as follows: Team playing 09:30 provides umpire for 11:15 game. Team playing at 11:15 provides umpire for 09.30. Division 2, 3 and 4 umpiring require the team to provide an umpire for the actual game

There is no injury time in BSDNL due to centralised timing. If a player needs to leave the court to receive treatment, they can return when there is a break in play. If a player is injured and you have another player free, an immediate substitution can be made
